11 Q. Did you see any injuries to Ms. Hockman?

12 A. No, I did not.

13 Q. Did she show you anything about her clothing?

14 A. She had claimed that he had grabbed her in the
15 chest area and she did unbutton the top buttons of her
16 clothing to examine and see if she had any marks on her.

17 Q. And did she show you her bare breasts to
18 determine if there were marks on them?

19 A. Yes.

20 Q. And, Deputy, did you see any marks on her
21 breasts?

22 A. No.

23 Q. And there was another individual there that was
24 driving the vehicle you stated?

25 A. Yes.

1 Q. Now, Deputy, do you make any charges that night?

2 A. No.

3 Q. Answer any questions defense counsel has.

4 COURT: Mr. Albertson.

6 Cross Examination by Mr. Albertson:

7 Q. Good afternoon, Deputy. Deputy Danner, did she
8 indicate that he had ripped her bra?
