The exchange of letter's between myself and C. Harris took place during AIA class on Wed. night's at that time everyone in the meeting just look at me in shock. I left went back to my pod, spoke C. Cubbage and S. Cutlip about what had happen and C. Cubbage said they should come talk to her, around or after my Court date 2-27-09 or the beginning of March 09 my lawyer and Donna Hockman's lawyer came and seen me, my lawyer told me I had the right to refuse to talk to Donna's lawyer, which I said I don't mind speaking to him, I told Donna Hockman's lawyer word from word what I had said at my meeting and even answer question's he had ask me about Donna's behavior around the pod and towards other, it seen to me that he didn't care, but he ask was call in court would I reply what I told him that's not what I want to do about J.

AFFIDAVIT

Commonwealth of Virginia v. Donna Jean Reedy Hockman

Re: The homicide of Dustin Ray Stout on July 25, 2008
Trial date of January 26, 2009 - January 29, 2009

I, Crystal Woods-Slade, [hereinafter referred to as the affiant], offer this affidavit with reasons set forth herein, to be applied in support of Donna Hockman's request filed with this office, for good cause shown, where the petitioner request for a Habeas review.

1. I was housed in the Rockingham County jail with Donna Hockman from July 2008-January 2009.
2. In February 2009, I was accompanied by my attorney Scott Hanson to meet with Commonwealth's attorney Eldridge, Detective Spiegel, another detective, (name unknown), and an intern, (name unknown), to sign my plea agreement for the charges with which I was arrested on. While sitting there, I made the comment that they would believe anything an inmate tells them. I was asked to explain and I said that the four inmates April Smith, Christian Harris, Melissa Loker and Jamie Lam that testified on Donna Hockman's case was lying. I was asked by Ms. Eldridge if I was for real which I replied "Yes."
3. I told them that Christian Harris was offering to "bribe" me for any information Donna may volunteer after meeting with her attorney Bruce Albertson.
4. I told them that Donna kept to herself and did not start any trouble in our housing unit. One time Christian Harris attempted to get into a fight with Donna over the lover of Christian Harris and Becky Van Fossen, who told at least (3)three family members during the visitation waiting area that Christian has hepatitis C, and Donna walked away.
5. The exchange of letters took place between Christian and me during our weekly AA meetings with Angel Harpine,

the teacher. Christian told her that she was getting on Donna Hockman's case and going home in (2) two weeks.

6. Upon my return from the meeting with the above-referenced parties during the signing of my plea agreement, I spoke with another inmate, Carmen Cabbage. She told me that she should be called out also so that she can tell them that she also knew about the conspiracy against Donna.

7. Cheryl Mullins, another inmate who was to testify against Donna's case was housed in our unit for (30) thirty days. I advised Donna only spoke to her in a group setting and in a casual conversation not including any details about the events surrounding the day of the shooting.

8. After Donna's conviction I was moved into the housing unit with April Smith, Jamie Lam, and Christian Harris. Christian stated at the AA meeting that she would be going home in two weeks which was the end of February. April stated that "I am going home because I had to do what I had to do, because the bitch needed to go to jail."

9. I have not been offered anything in exchange for the above statement in this affidavit. I am offering this information because it is the right thing to do.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
